Application Process

- Fill out the all four pages of the Registration Form.
- The following documents must accompany your registration:
 - A letter of reference from the pastor of your church; (**new** families to QCHS only)
 - A letter of reference from your previous school;
 - A copy of the your most recent transcript if you are currently in Grade 9, 10, 11 or 12;
 - A copy of your Individual Education Plan (IEP), if you have one;
 - A copy of the your birth certificate;
 - A Vulnerable Sector Police Check from parents
- New families please include a deposit of \$500. This will be refunded if your application is not successful, otherwise the deposit will go towards the tuition and will be non-refundable.

Criteria for Eligibility

- Parents agree to support the purpose of the school, which is to educate and disciple students as followers of Jesus Christ.
- At least one parent/guardian is required to be an active member of, or adherent to, a Christian church that agrees with the school's foundational guidelines. (See Pastoral Recommendation)
- Parents/guardians and the student agree that the student will participate in all compulsory courses and school activities.
- Parents agree to the school rules and discipline procedures, respecting the authority in the school.
- Parents sign the "Responsibilities of being a Parent at QCHS".
- The student signs the "Responsibilities of being a Student at QCHS".
- An appropriate program placement is available to the student.
- Parents agree to pay tuition set by the Board.
- All parts of the application listed above are complete.

Eligibility Process

- Potential families interviewed by principal and admissions committee.
- The principal presents the application to the QCHS Board of Directors.
- The principal will inform the parents of the Board's decision.
- The process may take up to six weeks to complete.

Registration Fees and Deadlines

- Registrations before **March 31** are assured of placement and transportation for the coming school year.
- Registrations after **March 31** will be subject to budget and staff constraints. Placement and/or transportation cannot be guaranteed.
